*The prices above and the number of students served below are based on local big box stores and Hayes K-8 School current classroom setting.

COST ANALYSIS

- Each bag would cost between \$4.89/\$5.00.
- 37 classrooms x 3 students per classroom = 111 students.
- 111 students x \$5.00/bag = \$555.00/month. This is our starting goal, but we hope to serve more students as soon as possible.
- Annually 10 months x 111 students = \$5,550.00/year

An IPC member could contribute \$50/annually to feed one student monthly for 10 months of school. The more IPC members donate the items, or make financial contributions, the more students we can serve. As of January 2022, Hayes K-8 has 700 students enrolled, all of whom experience food insecurity and live in a food desert.
